- The format of the recording should be .MOV or MP4.
- The quality of the sound and video does not have an effect on the later selection process.
- The length of the two recorded pieces should not exceed 20min for each recording
- The two pieces should represent two different styles.

The closing date for applications for the 2021/22 Scholarships is November 30th 2021. Applicants should be born after 1<sup>st</sup> April 1996 and must be a current student enrolled on a full-time music course at a UK or Ireland conservatoire or university.
